Some events take place at a different location. Transport is booked for this. A schedule of the trips can be found later in the guide. Help us avoid delays by arriving 5 minutes early.

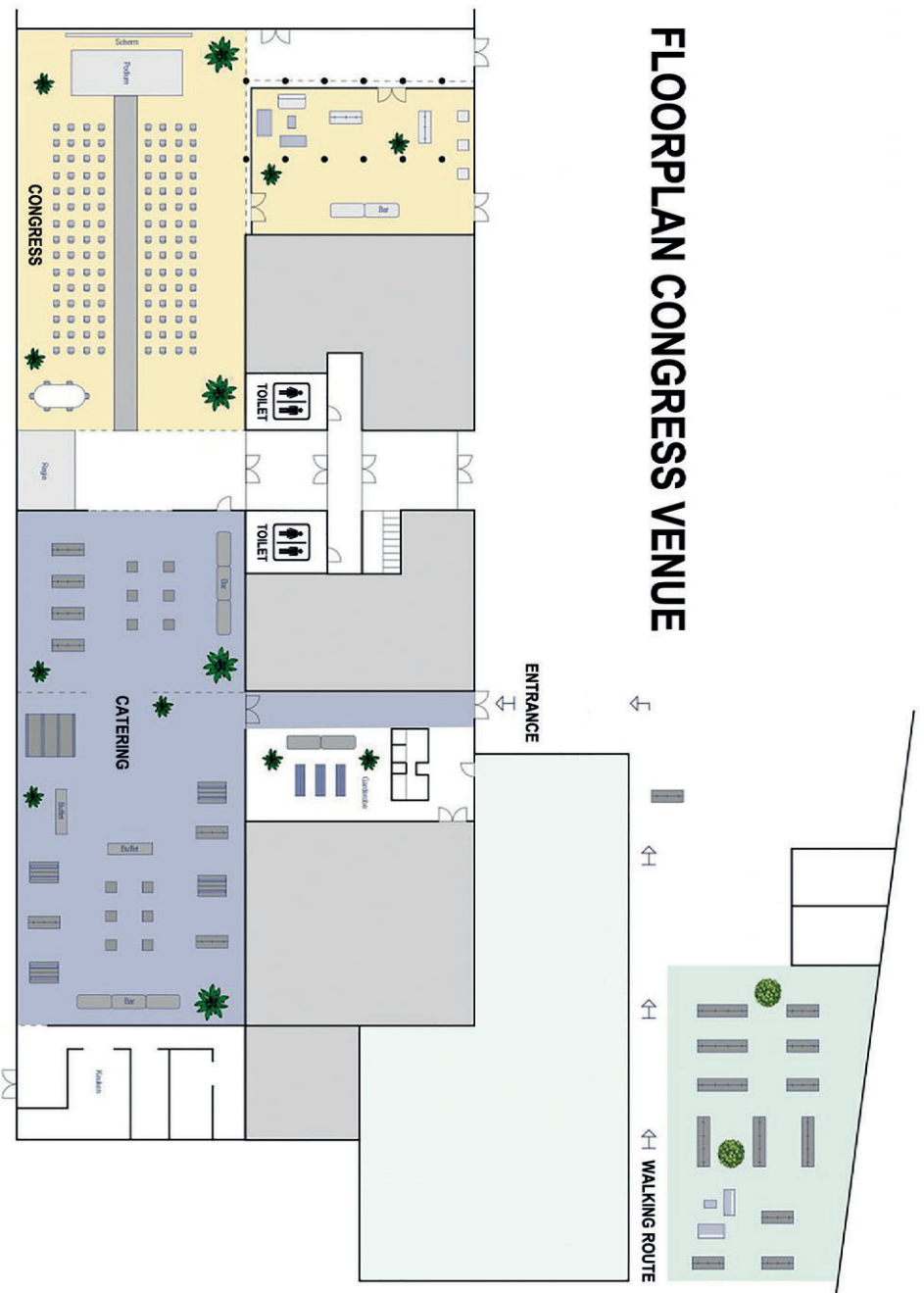
Congress badge

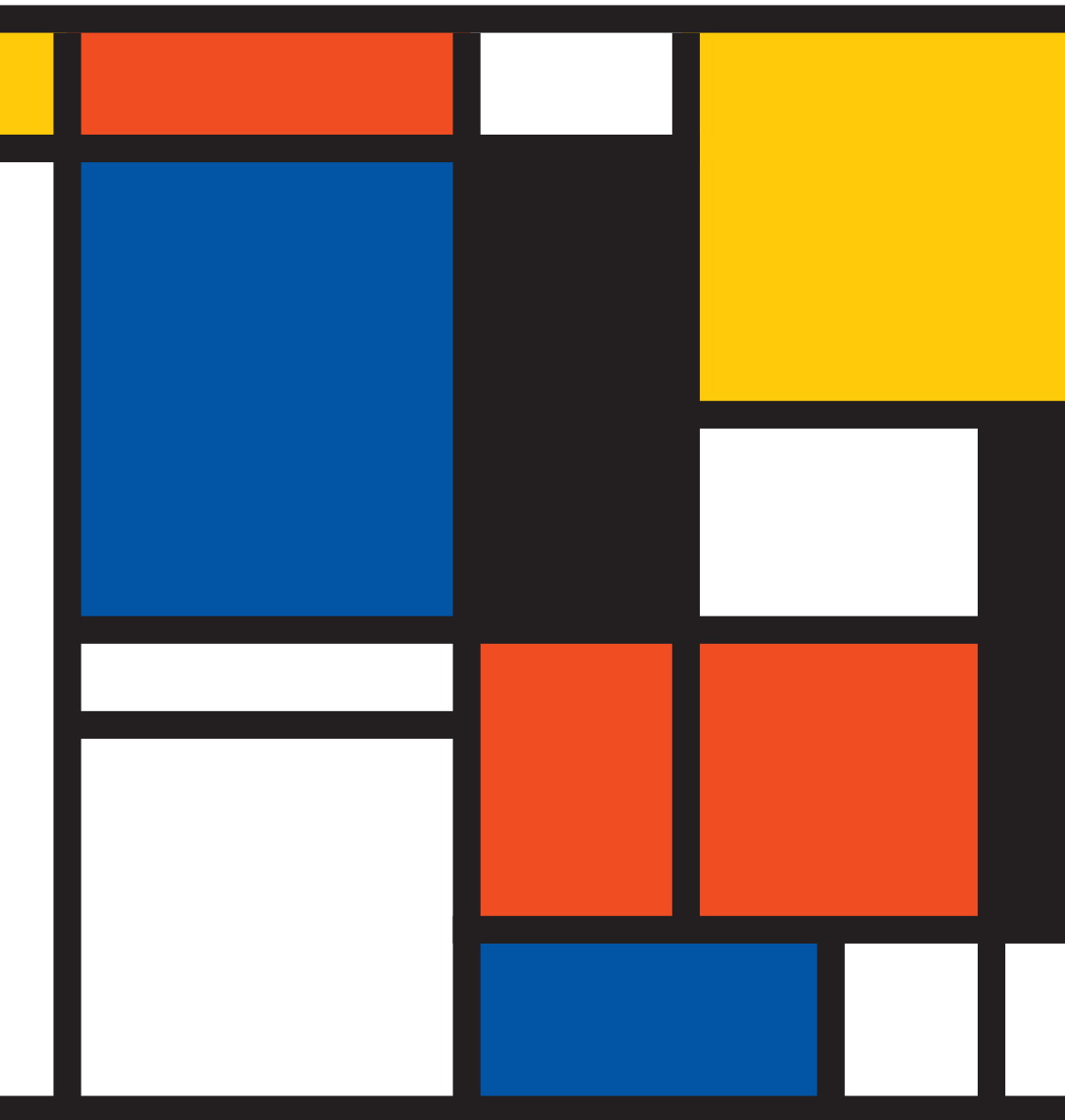

PIET MONDRIAAN



Pieter Cornelis (Piet) Mondriaan
(Amersfoort, March 7, 1872 – New York, February 1, 1944)
was a Dutch painter and art theorist, who lived and worked
abroad later in life.



Mondrian is generally seen as a pioneer of abstract and non-figurative art. His later geometric-abstract work in particular, with the characteristic horizontal and vertical black lines and primary colors, is world famous and serves as a source of inspiration for many architects and designers of applied art. He was one of the most important contributors to the magazine *De Stijl* and developed his own art theory, which he called new plasticism or neoplasticism. He is better known abroad as Mondrian, a change he introduced himself after he moved to Paris.

Mondriaan's birthplace is located in Amersfoort: the Mondriaan House. Piet also spent his childhood here. It is now a museum about this famous Dutch artist. In the Mariënhof, where part of the conference and the party will take place, some works of art by Piet Mondriaan are also visible, which have been temporarily made available by the Mondriaan House.
